NOTICES

PERMITS: There are Town Ordinances regarding mobile homes, buildings, fences, etc., so please make sure to read and check on building permits, mobile home/trailer permits, or home improvements, etc. You can find the Town Ordinances on our website under the government tab.

NOTICE TO DOG OWNERS: *Please be considerate - clean up after your dogs, both in your yard and in public spaces.* Make sure your dog contained/restrained at all times. Dogs running at large are not allowed and will be reported to Town Code Enforcement Officer, Tim Pawol. All dogs require registration/licenses that can be obtained at Town Hall; **please bring proof of vaccination.**

WATER METER ACCESS - PLEASE CLEAR A PATH!! Property owners are responsible to make sure their water meter is accessible. Inaccessible meters have been estimated in the past due to being snow covered or unable to access. Per Ordinance, the **OWNER** of the property is responsible and may be charged an **ADDITIONAL \$40 FEE** if your meter is unreadable or inaccessible. **Winter is still here, please make sure your meter is clear.**



Auto Pay for your water/sewer bill: Did you know you can now pay your utility bill by text? Auto pay is also available. Your bill will be paid timely, on a specific day of the month. No more writing a check or stopping by Town Hall to pay before the 20th. If you don't want to use auto pay, you can still sign up to use **xpressbillpay** and pay online at your convenience. **It's free to sign up and free to use!**

MAYOR'S MINUTE

Several meetings have been held this month preparing for the water meter replacement bidding and project. A formal request was sent to SLIB requesting an interest rate reduction on the water meter loan. Publication for bids and a bid opening should be complete within a month. Meetings continue regarding the Franks Meats waterline project. Grant applications are currently being prepared to cover engineering costs for assessing Hudson's sewer lines, lift station, and sewer lagoon, and the costs of continuing the "Bring Back Svilar Park" project. A warranty claim is being processed for the replacement of the flooring in Town Hall. Meetings and plans continue for Hudson Daze, the Ballpark revitalization, and improvements for Gold Star Memorial Park, including coordinating volunteer help from the local Girl Scouts, Cub Scouts, and VFW. The Wyoming DEQ Brownstone Project committee believes Hudson would qualify for their program to help preserving some of main street buildings and will be giving a presentation to Town Council. I participated with a recent Republican Committee tax forum held in Riverton. Budget planning is beginning. Town Code Enforcement has begun and we are already getting record numbers of pet licensing. The town is looking at modifying Hudson's dog ordinance to identify "vicious" dogs versus specific breeds.
