<u>PERMITS:</u> There are Town Ordinances regarding mobile homes, buildings, fences, etc., so please make sure to read and check on building permits, mobile home/trailer permits, or home improvements, etc. You can find the Town Ordinances on our website under the government tab.

NOTICE TO DOG OWNERS: Please be considerate - clean up after your dogs, both in your yard and in public spaces. Make sure your dog contained/restrained at all times. Dogs running at large are not allowed and will be reported to Town Code Enforcement Officer, Tim Pawol. All dogs require registration/licenses that can be obtained at Town Hall; please bring proof of vaccination. For your convenience, a special Saturday registration will be available at Town Hall on March 9th from Noon until 2 o'clock.

<u>WATER METER ACCESS</u> - PLEASE CLEAR A PATH!! Property owners are responsible to make sure their water meter is accessible. Inaccessible meters have been estimated this in the past due to being snow covered or unable to access. Per Ordinance, the **OWNER** of the property is responsible and may be charged an <u>ADDITIONAL \$40 FEE</u> if your meter is unreadable or inaccessible. <u>Winter is still here, please make sure your meter is clear.</u>



Auto Pay for your water/sewer bill: Did you know you can now pay your utility bill by text? Auto pay is also available. Your bill will be paid timely, on a specific day of the month. No more writing a check or stopping by Town Hall to pay before the 20th. If you don't want to use auto pay, you can still sign up to use xpressbillpay and pay online at your convenience. It's free to sign up and free to use!

MAYOR'S MINUTE

Hudson's WWDC Level 1 Master Plan is waiting for State Legislative approval. Flood Mitigation: the Popo Agie Conservation District agreed to assist us with our project. Hudson applied for two FEMA grants for an engineer report on this project. The sewer lift station parts are delayed but should be installed mid-March unless delayed. Hudson's Digital sign (donated by the WRVC) is installed and working! Hudson's ballpark and cemetery committees were formed and our fundraising comedy night, despite the ugly weather, was a success! Hudson's Water Meter Project is ready to start the bidding process. I continue working with the Wyoming Business Council for assistance on improvements to Hudson's Main Street. The FCAG letter of interest will be submitted to the Governor's State Shooting Complex Task Force by the end of the month. God's Pantry is open and providing food and assistance for the needy! Hudson code enforcement has begun with pet licensing, other code enforcement is coming next. Frank's Meats waterline project bid opening is February 29. — Sherry Oler
